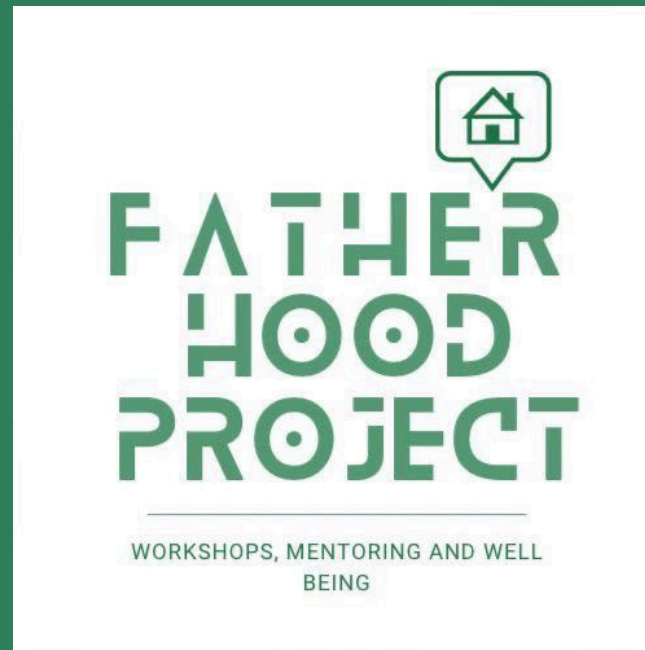

ABOUT US & MISSION

Our Mission

The Fatherhood Project exists to break the cycle of fatherlessness in young people by providing structured mentoring, workshops, and wellbeing support. We address the root causes of youth violence, exclusion, and poor life outcomes by filling the gap left by absent father figures.

Who We Are

Founded in 2023 and operating across London and Bedfordshire, The Fatherhood Project is a community interest organisation led by CEO Marlon H. We are governed by a board of two Directors, Advisory Board members and supported by a committee of managers. Over three years of delivery, we have built a proven model that is ready to scale.

The Problem We Solve

Fatherlessness is one of the strongest predictors of youth involvement in crime, poor mental health, school exclusion, and gang affiliation. Young people without positive male role models are significantly more likely to enter the criminal justice system. Our intervention disrupts this trajectory through early, consistent, and structured engagement.

Strategic Alignment

Our work directly aligns with Violence Reduction Unit (VRU) priorities, taking a public health approach to crime prevention. We tackle the root causes of serious youth violence through early intervention, mentoring, and family support — reducing demand on policing, courts, and custody.

What We Deliver

1:1 Mentoring Programme

Structured, long-term mentoring for young men aged 11-25 affected by fatherlessness, exclusion, or involvement in the criminal justice system.

Group Workshops

Interactive sessions covering identity, emotional regulation, conflict resolution, healthy masculinity, and goal-setting.

Wellbeing & Mental Health Support

Safe spaces for young people to process trauma, build resilience, and develop coping strategies.

Family Mediation & Support

Working with families to rebuild relationships and create stable home environments.

Schools & PRU Outreach

Delivering targeted interventions in schools and Pupil Referral Units to reduce exclusions and improve engagement.

Work Experience & Employment

Offering vital work experience to offer an alternative to crime and illegal influences.

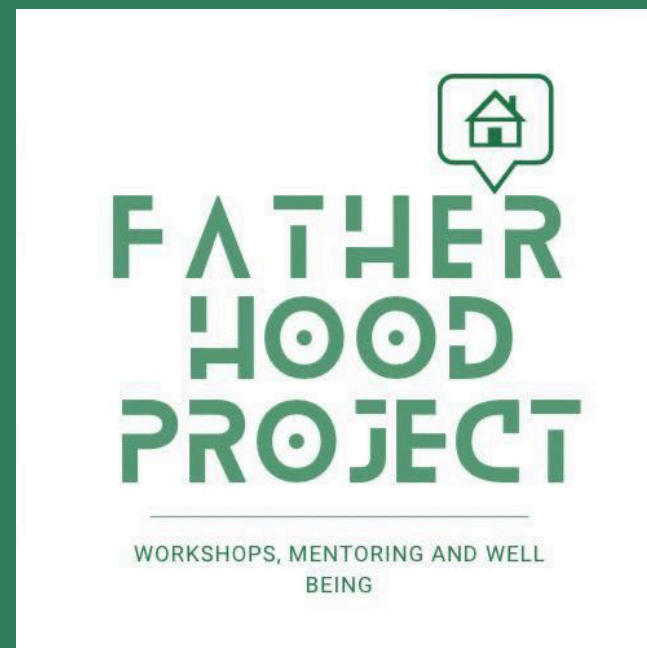
